

MetalTech-USA Clads Carlsbad Joint First Responders

MetalTech-USA is pleased to announce that it will be cladding the architectural applications for the \$16.5 million Carlsbad Joint First Responder Training Facility in Carlsbad, CA. The two-story 36,000 square foot facility will serve as the world-class training facility for emergency and law enforcement personnel.

Once completed, emergency and law enforcement personnel will no longer have to travel outside of the community to receive professional training. The training center will feature multiple areas for personnel to practice drills, including a rescue tower for firefighters and an underground facility for advanced extrication training.

The zinc metal cladding used will be a 0.8mm (22 GA) with PVC film applied. The zinc cladding will be engineered to satisfy California seismic performance requirements. A MT Flat Lock Panel system fabricated from graphite gray zinc will also be used in the cladding.

“Zinc is a practical solution for the wall cladding in the Carlsbad Joint First Responders facility because of its durability,” said MetalTech-USA President Nils Simonsen. “By working closely with Architectural Systems, Inc., we were able to provide a different level of support for this project,” said Simonsen of MetalTech-USA’s partnership with the company.
